St. David's was delighted to welcome David and Michelle

Sturtevant to visit St. John's and the congregation January 19-23, 2017. Despite a storm on Saturday, which cancelled that day's events, many members from various aspects of the life and ministry of the congregation had an opportunity to meet, eat and spend fellowship time with them. David preached for the Call on January 22nd and, at a congregational meeting following the service, a unanimous vote of members present, and 96% of adherents present, expressed a desire to call David to be the Minister at St. David's. Session is currently collecting signatures of members and adherents who were unable to be present and support this call at the meeting. The Presbytery of Newfoundland will meet at 1:00 P.M., February 1, 2017 at St. Andrew's to consider the Call. Congregation members are invited to be present at the Presbytery meeting, and voice their support, or express any concerns. Provided our Presbytery is satisfied there is no impediment, the Call will be forwarded to David's home presbytery of Waterloo-Wellington, where the terms will be reviewed. If these meetings advance as we hope, David will be ordained February 12, 2017 in the church where he grew up, St. Andrew's, Kitchener, Ontario, before commencing work at St. David's March 1, 2017. An Induction service would likely take place at St. David's sometime in March, at a time directed by our Presbytery.
