#### Minister's Message



This week was the annual meeting of the Presbyterian Synod of the Atlantic Provinces. The location rotates around, but this year we met in New Glasgow, NS, and were hosted by First Presbyterian Church. As is the norm in the courts of the Presbyterian church, this meeting of around 80 people was made up half of ministers and half of elders, sharing meals together, doing workshops, and worshipping together.

Newfoundland was represented by myself, Lynne Allen from the church in Grand Falls-Windsor, Mike Gillan from St. Andrew's, and Rev. Ian Wishart as well. Most of the business of synod, which is light, has to do with the various church camps that run in the Maritimes. If you know a young person who might be interested in attending camp as a camper or staff person, let me know and I can put you in touch with the right people. Funding for travel may be available.

The real benefit of Synod has always been more than the business we do. This year, we had a wonderful speaker in the Rev. Dr. Patricia Dutcher-Walls, the recently retired Dean and Professor of Hebrew Bible at Vancouver School of Theology. She put us to work in small groups studying stories from all across the scriptures, and then brought us back together to ask what common themes we could learn about God. We heard the stories of Naaman being cured of leprosy, Ruth the Moabite becoming King David's great-grandmother, Jesus healing untouchable people, Philip baptizing a foreign eunuch, and Peter baptizing a Roman centurion. All of these stories tell of God's love of diverse people, and the ways that God will even break or change His own laws to include them. This method of study and looking for overarching themes in scripture was excellent, and is an approach I will be trying to adapt for us to use somehow here at St. David's.

I was also glad for the opportunity to walk around down by the river and take some less-than-serious pictures as a tourist. It is a beautiful time of year to be out and walking.

May God bless you with refreshment this week, whether it come from conversation with new friends or old ones, whether it come from walking in creation or sitting in prayer. For God cares for us, and has good things in store. That's Good News!

#### **New Choir – Spiritoso Singers**


