The minister turns to the couple, and asks questions

Congregational Promise

The Minister turns to the congregation, and puts this question:

* Do you, as members of the church of Jesus Christ, promise to guide and nurture Julian by word and deed, with love and prayer, encourage him to follow the way of Christ and to be a faithful member of his church? If so respond; we do.

We do.

May God richly bless you and give you grace faithfully to fulfill the promises made this day.

Confession of Faith

As we remain standing, turn to the Baptismal insert as we confess our faith together in the words of the Apostles Creed. Please join with me.

I believe in God, the Father almighty,
creator of heaven and earth.

I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord.
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit
born of the virgin Mary.
suffered under Pontius Pilate,
was crucified, died, and was buried.
He descended to the dead.
On the third day he rose again.
He ascended into heaven,
is seated at the right hand of the Father.
He will come again to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.
