Treasurer's Message re our Oil Bill

Some members of our congregation donate to our church through their monthly PAD. We, too, have a PAD - with Irving Oil of \$2,036 per month. On June 1st Irving's invoice said that come November, we will owe \$9,700.30 above our monthly payments. We had no deliveries in June. On July 4, Irving Oil delivered another 1,203.2 litres costing \$2,162.89. Taking this into account, our monthly payment does not cover the July 4th delivery. Hence come November we will now owe Irving \$9,827.19. Summer is nigh, please conserve our heating costs whenever possible. Thank you.
